

Provence In A Day

Enjoy a full day discovering the most beautiful places in Provence.

Arrival in the exceptional village Les Baux de Provence. From the Middle Ages, the village kept the narrow streets, the ruins of a castle and the memory of the proud lords and troubadours. From the rocky spur, the view on an exceptional scenery is breathtaking. Then visit the Pont du Gard, a fascinating Unesco World Heritage site and the best preserved part of the aqueduct of Nimes. The Roman architects and hydraulic engineers who designed this bridge, which stands almost 50 m high and is on three levels, created a technical as well as an artistic masterpiece. Continue to Avignon, the city of the Popes in the 14th century : the medieval walls, the Pont d'Avignon on the Rhone river and the Popes' Palace, the biggest gothic palace in all Europe (entrance fees not included). Continuation to Chateauneuf-du-Pape surrounded by the so famous vineyards. Wine-tasting included in a wine cellars.
