Discover the International Geneva through the world's peacemaking organizations. Hear all about the peaceful site and diplomatic places such as Red Cross, UN, Unicef, WTO. Let yourself enjoy the beautiful shores of Lake Geneva, its attraction as the famous fountain "Jet d'eau" and the flower clock. Explore Geneva old town on our mini-train, you will be taking a step back in time with Saint Peter's cathedral: known as the church where John Calvin gave his inspiring sermons during the mid-16th century. The imposing Romanesque-Gothic church with a neoclassical facade still dominates the center of the international Swiss town. On this stroll, you will also explore Place Bourg-de-four, original market place, the arsenal and the town hall; lose yourself in the grandeur and beauty of this culturally influential town.
