

3 Days Tour to in Normandy and Loire Valley by Motor Coach

This three-day tour will delight you as you the explore France's rich cultural heritage with a guide-interpreter. Tour the Beaches of Normandy after first visiting two Norman towns: Honfleur and Rouen. Continue your journey with a tour of Saint-Malo and Mont Saint-Michel. Finish your trip in the Loire Valley with a visit to Langeais, Chenonceau and Chambord.

At 7:15 am you will set off on the Normandy highway after passing through the western districts of Paris. After about two hours on the road, the bus will make its first stop in the city of Rouen. Your guide will take you on a walking tour of the historic district. Next stop will be in Honfleur where you will have the chance to explore the town on your own. After lunch the bus will set off again, this time along the Norman coastline. Explore the famous Normandy beaches where the Allies landed on June 6, 1944. Visit The American Cemetery in Colleville sur Mer. Next stop is Arromanches beach. Your first day ends at the Caen Novotel (or a similar hotel) where you will have dinner and spend the night. Drive to Saint-Malo for a guided tour of the city, a town with a rich heritage. During the afternoon, let your guide introduce you to the incredible Mont Saint-Michel. Enjoy a guided tour of Mont Saint-Michel abbey. Drive to the city of Angers where you will have dinner and spend the night. You will then set off for the Loire Valley and the first tour will take place at Chateau de Langeais, a well-preserved fortified castle. You will then be driven to Amboise for lunch. Enjoy a guided tour of Chateau de Chenonceau. Your journey continues with an hour-long ride to Chateau de Chambord. The bus will leave Chambord at 6:30 pm and arrive in downtown Paris around 9:00 pm.
