Pedaling on a 2300 year old Roman cobblestone road, while going past an ancient sepulcher, a roman statue is the ruins of a circus and an imperial palace. We will leave the "regina viarum" and head towards the ancient Roman aqueducts that rise over the fields into the horizon and following them on their way to Rome. We will go through the Caffarella Park, a preserved strip of land of the Roman countryside that so well impressed the 19th century travelers such as Byron, Goethe and Stendhal. On this tour, we will take a journey into a unique environment, containing miraculously intact nature, free from modernizations, forming a backdrop to the continuous passage of historical, cultural and artistic events.
