On our way to Oia, we stop at the idyllic Santo Winery to enjoy the most wonderful view of the caldera. Our last stop is the breath taking Oia village. Oia is famous for being the place of gathering artists, who are inspired by the beauty of the landscape and the magnificent purple sunset.
