

Full Day in Pompeii and Vesuvius

Here is your chance to visit Pompeii, one of the most attractive sites in Italy, and the famous Mount Vesuvius, the only active volcano on the mainland of Europe.

Walk through some of the ancient streets of Pompeii where you can see the baths, forums and villas built by the prosperous Romans in the year 80 BC. Marvel at the fabulously preserved frescoes which adorned the walls and floors of the villas. Even if your interests do not lie in history, you will still be incredibly impressed by this massive archaeological site. You will be able to visit some of these fascinating spots, the Amphitheatre, Gymnasium, House of Menandro, The Grand theatre and Small theatre, Gladiators Barracks, Thermal baths, House of Vetti. The guided tour of the ruins will last approximately two hours. The other part of the excursion will take you to visit Mount Vesuvius, one of the most famous volcanoes on earth. It is also the only active volcano on the mainland of Europe and provides the focal point of the entire Bay of Naples. Our transport and local expert will take you up to 1,000 meters and from there you can walk to the very top and admire the splendid panoramic views across the bay. Peer into the crater where a single plume of smoke rises, reminding us that the volcano is only just sleeping.
